## A Message from Albemarle County School District

We are excited to announce online registration verification for the 2017-2018 school year is now open! Your verification is now available online. You will need to use the PowerSchool Parent Portal to access the InfoSnap registration system. We request that you submit registration verifications for all students by **Friday, September 15th, 2017**.

### How do I get started?

If you have a PowerSchool Parent Portal account, go to <https://sis.k12albemarle.org/> and sign in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal. From the Parent Portal:

1. Select the student you wish to update along the top
  2. Either:
    - Click the Student Registration Verification button on the left sidebar
    - Or*
    - Click the Applications icon in the top right corner and select Student Registration Verification
  3. Enter your student's date of birth to verify access to the form
  4. Follow the prompts to begin the form
  5. Review all information on each page and make changes where necessary
- If you do not yet have a parent portal account, please contact your student's school.*
