Spanish: reading *Pete el Gato*, practicing family vocabulary, drawing Pete using Kids Art Hub

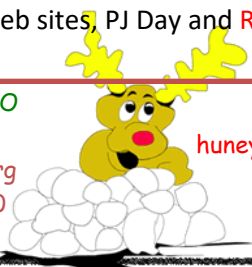
Other Fun Stuff: pinecone turkey centerpieces, Thanksgiving web sites, PJ Day and Read Every Day celebration
